Quick guide to completing the Vetting Form and Identification Form

The requirements described below are those required by the Garda Vetting Unit, incomplete or illegible forms will be returned directly to the applicant.

Vetting Application Form

1. Use **BLOCK CAPITALS** to complete all sections
2. Fill in your **SURNAME, PREVIOUS NAME** if any (e.g. maiden name) and full **FORENAME(s)** – do not put initials – full names must be entered
3. Fill in any **ALIAS** you may use (this means any other name you might commonly be known by)
4. Complete your **DATE of BIRTH** using the format **dd/mm/yyyy**
5. Write your **PLACE OF ORIGIN** (this is the town, town-land or city where you were born)
6. Tick **YES** or **NO** where asked **HAVE YOU EVER CHANGED YOUR NAME?** (If YES then write your former name(s) in the space provided).
7. State **ALL YOUR ADDRESSES** (Irish and foreign) from **your year of birth up to your current address** indicating the years from and to spent at each of the addresses on your list
Please ensure the list is complete and in sequence covering all the years from your birth year to the present day
8. Tick **YES** or **NO** where asked 'Have you ever been convicted of an offence in the Republic of Ireland or elsewhere?' (If you tick YES you must then write in the details of your offence in the space provided)
9. **FILL IN THE POSITION** you have applied for and **SIGN** and **DATE** the form in the **DECLARATION OF APPLICANT** section; if your signature contains an initial letter you must state what name the initial letter stands for

Identification Form

1. Complete all sections – your address and information will be checked against the information you have supplied on the Vetting Application form
2. Ask a responsible person (Chairperson/Designated Person or someone with a similar standing if outside the club) to verify your identification and sign Section 2.
