Eligibility	Only swimmers registered with Connacht are eligible to enter this gala. Limited consideration entry will be in place for entry into the, 800m and 1500m mixed fastest entry times. Time dependant clubs will be notified. Age 12yrs or older as on 31st Dec 2023. Age 12yrs may enter 50/10/200/400m freestyle, 100/200m Backstroke, 100/200m Breaststroke, 100/200m Butterfly & 200m IM. Tech Suit Policy: Tech Suits will NOT be permitted for 12y Athletes. We ask clubs to ensure coaches, parents and athletes are fully aware of the policy so that we avoid any negative experiences on poolside. Entries by:	Wednesday 25 January 2023	
Officials	Clubs must provide volunteers for timekeeping duties. Different arrangements may apply to the rostering of officials for long distance events (800m, 1500m). Volunteers should be trained to Level 1 Officials standard.	
	Officials will be arranged directly by the region in accordance with the licence category. Officials seeking specific duties for experiences may request particular roles.	
Heats	Clubs will be notified in advance as to any changes to the competition. Numbers of heats may be curtailed to allow the gala to be run off in a reasonable time-frame.	
FINA Rules	This swim meet will be run under FINA rules. In particular, please note that the regulations relating to FINA-approved swimsuits will be enforced.	
Scratches	Scratches 6pm day prior to commencement, (or otherwise as directed at the swim meet).	
Medals	In accordance with national Swim Ireland policy, there will be no presentation of medals at this event.	
Finals	All Heat Declared Winners HDW.	
Data Protection	Swim Ireland Connacht and its registered clubs use a software database to manage entries and results of swimming meets, and also to manage competition records of swimmers. By submitting and accepting entries, consent is hereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act, to the holding of personal information on databases. Personal data held for each swimmer will be name, date of birth, club, Swim Ireland registration number, entry times, achieved times. Certain elements of this data (name club, age, times, achieved times) may be made public prior to, during or after the mee (e.g. programmes, results sheets, social media updates etc.)	
Qualification	Athletes must be at least 12 years of age to compete at these meets. National Squad/Programme athletes are permitted to swim in these meets.	
	Times achieved can be used to enter the Regional LC Championships, Irish Open Championships, Irish Summer National Age Group/ Youth Championships, .	
	Times will only be accepted and recorded on the National Database when ALL Meet paperwork has been submitted after the Meet and all the conditions of the licence have been satisfied.	
Hydration	Please note that, as an environment-friendly measure, timekeepers/officials/coaches are encouraged to bring their own bottles.	
First Aid	First Aid facilities will be provided by facility lifeguards and staff.	
	Fire exits should be noted on arrival. In the event of fire alarm, swimmers and volunteers will take direction from the facility staff and / or Meet Director.
